

One of our year 8 geography classes recorded some data around school as part of their microclimate investigation.




They recorded the temperature, wind speed and direction (using their ties) and drew field sketches around school to record the level of sun/shade at all different places

Absences should always be followed up by written confirmation from the parent/carer. Your co-operation would be greatly appreciated.



There is a clear link between poor attendance at school and lower academic achievement – how can your child learn if they are not here?

Attendance is important because your child will not make progress if they do not attend school. If your child receives an attendance figure of 90% every year of their school life, they would miss over a whole year of their schooling.

We need your help to raise whole school attendance.

Any students who arrive late to school or lessons will be issued with a red Late Slip and **MUST** attend a Late Detention for 30 minutes after school on the **SAME** day.


