This guide will help parents understand what Century Tech is, how children can log in, complete homework, and make the most of the platform.

What is Century Tech?

CENTURY is an online learning and homework platform that uses AI (artificial intelligence) and learning science to personalise students' learning. It provides:


- Interactive revision lessons broken into small chunks
- Teacher-assigned courses and homework
- It adapts to each student: identifying strengths and gaps, and recommending "nuggets" (small learning tasks) targeted to their level


How to Log In

- I. Go to add webpage: https://app.century.tech/login/
- 2. Sign in with Office 365
- 3. Click accept
- 4. Once logged in, your child will see the courses assigned by their teacher on the homepage.



• Ensure they are using the correct email address linked to their school account.





How to Start and Complete Homework

- I. Go to 'My assignments' tab where upcoming tasks and past ones are listed.
- 2. Click on an assignment name to see its details: due date, instructions, how much of it is done. Century Tech
- 3. Start the Assignment / Nugget by clicking on it to open it
- 4. Work on the Nugget. Each nugget is a small learning activity, often with slides, video, or minilessons to teach or remind before asking questions.
- 5. If a question is answered wrong, feedback is often given immediately, and there may be an option to reveal correct answers.
- 6. Once complete students can submit their assignments.

Tips for Parents

- Encourage your child to spread out homework and revision
- Sit with your child occasionally to see how Seneca works—it is very visual and interactive.
- Remind them to retry incorrect questions to reinforce learning.
- Check progress reports by asking your child to show you their assignment scores.
