This guide will help parents understand what EverLearner is, how children can log in, complete homework, and make the most of the platform.

What is EverLearner?

EverLearner is an online learning platform used by many schools to support students with their studies, especially in subjects like V-CERT PE, GCSE and A-Level PE, Science, and Computer Science. It offers:

- Video tutorials
- Practice questions
- Homework assignments set by teachers
- Progress tracking for students

How to Log In to EverLearner

Go to www.everlearner.com in a web browser

In the top-right corner of the homepage, click "Login".

Enter Login Details

Username: School email address e.g 22jbloggs@hornchurchhigh.com

Password: Password!! (this is a default password and can be changed once logged in)

If login doesn't work:

- Ensure they are using the correct email address linked to their school account.
- Reset the password by clicking 'Forgot password?'

How to Start and Complete Homework

1. On the left-hand menu or under the "Homework" tab, click to view any assignments set by the teacher.
2. Click on the homework title to open it.
3. Homework usually includes a video lesson followed by questions (multiple choice, written answers, or interactive activities).
4. Watch the Video
5. Answer Questions
6. Once finished, click "Submit".
7. Your child's teacher will receive the completed work and may provide feedback.

Tips for Parents

- Check in regularly: Ask your child to show you their dashboard or completed tasks.
- Set a routine: Help your child set a regular time each week to complete EverLearner tasks.
- Use headphones: Videos may include narration, so headphones can help your child focus.
